understanding (MOU)

with Fengsha Group,

China's largest

privately owned

processor of

photovoltaic (solar)

and speciality high

end sand.

Diatreme chief
executive **Neil****McIntyre** said the sand

will be supplied from the

company's Galalar silica

project north of Cooktown,

with production about 15

months away.

After processing on site the sand will be shipped direct to China where it will be used to make glass for solar panels. The solar panel market is set to reach \$US48 billion (\$68.3 billion) by 2025, up from \$US3.3 billion in 2016, with the Asia-Pacific region the fastest growing market.

There is potential for Diatreme to supply half a million tonnes of the sand per annum under the MOU.
